

Cupids Community Garden Contract

The Cupids community Garden was established in 2015, as part of a Wellness and Social Development Grant with the Provincial Government. There are six community plots that are available each year on a first come first serve basis. If you are a resident of Cupids you are eligible to acquire a plot for the coming year.

If you are a successful candidate there are several responsibilities associated with the using your plot. We ask that you maintain your garden throughout the summer months, weeding the soil as necessary to cut down on weeds spreading to other plots in the garden. This is an important requirement, as there are several varieties of weeds that can consume an area very quickly, and stunt or even kill other plants in the plot. We also ask that at the end of the growing season, you leave your plot in the same condition you had acquired it. This means removing vegetation and turning the soil over to prepare it for the winter months. In following these two basic steps the garden will be ready for the following year.

These garden plots are for the use of all citizens who are interested and if we follow the above guidelines they will be available for many years to come.
