Twenty five signs bring you information about the cultural and natural history as well as intriguing stories about the abandoned communities along the way.

You don't have to hike to experience them! You can take a [Virtual Tour](#) wherever you are and experience these stories of the old ways of life. Complete with photos and sound bites, the blog site presents the history and folklore of the two areas—stories about houses that moved, where the Father, Son, and Holy Ghost once stood, and how some folks avoided mischievous fairies. You'll also learn a little about the ancient and powerful tectonic forces that folded and tilted the layered bedrock, to glaciers that shaped the landscape thousands of years before the first humans arrived.
